June Activities:

At least **1,739** people participated in June's programming. This number does not include the full attendance for the opening and closing parties of the summer reading program, estimated to be around **1,200** people in total.

Summer Reading:

- 865 people registered for the Summer Reading Challenge.
- Participants submitted 1,712 reading logs/tickets for a chance to win a prize basket.
- 17 prize baskets designed for all ages were available to win in the challenge.
- Approximately 92 new library cards were issued or renewed due to the program.
- Patrons saved \$53,559 by checking out material in June, significantly above the monthly average of \$39,361.
