June Activities:

At least **1,739** people participated in June's programming. This number does not include the full attendance for the opening and closing parties of the summer reading program, estimated to be around 1,200 people in total.

Summer Reading:

- 865 people registered for the Summer Reading Challenge.
- Participants submitted 1,712 reading logs/tickets for a chance to win a prize basket.
- 17 prize baskets designed for all ages were available to win in the challenge.
- Approximately 92 new library cards were issued or renewed due to the program.
- Patrons saved \$53,559 by checking out material in June, significantly above the monthly average of \$39,361.
